Local environmental group will present award to Woodside Artist Jim Caldwell at October 30 event

Committee for Green Foothills will present the first Jane Gallagher Award to Woodside artist Jim Caldwell at *Nature's Inspirations: Celebrating the Arts* on Saturday, October 30.

The award is given in memory of Jane Gallagher, a dedicated Committee for Green Foothills board member, a celebrated painter and passionate defender of open space on the Peninsula. The Committee is presenting the award in recognition of another artist whose work, like Jane's, honors the places, people and organizations that inspire the protection of open space.

Award winner Jim Caldwell is one of twelve Bay Area landscape painters selected to show at the art exhibition and sale *Nature's Inspirations: Celebrating the Arts* on October 30 in Woodside.

Jim Caldwell says of his work , "With my painting I am trying to make the public more aware of the beauty of nature which surrounds us on the Peninsula, and the importance of its preservation." Caldwell was born in New York in 1942 and moved to the Bay Area in 1950. Caldwell has had 24 one-man shows and participated in 18 group shows. He has paintings in more than 250 collections worldwide from Paris to Japan. He divides his time between painting and a practice in residential architecture at his studio in Woodside, California.

The runner-up for the Jane Gallagher Award is Patricia Wallis of Novato. Other artists selected for the exhibition are JoAnne Horsfall Beasley, Kay Duffy, Timothy Horn, Kerri Lawnsby, Julia Munger Seelos, Carolyn Shaw, Sheila Sondik, Michelle Waters, Alex White, and Thomas Wood. Works by all twelve artists will be for sale at *Nature's Inspirations*, and will also be featured in a live auction led by Assemblymember Joe Simitian.
